Kaiser Permanente will open a medical office in Santa Monica next spring at Tenth Street and Broadway.

Like all donations to SMMEF, the gift from Kaiser will fund programs for every school in the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District (SMMUSD). SMMEF-funded staff and programs include arts education for the district's 4,900 elementary students, 87 instructional assistants, and enrichment grants for all 16 schools in the district.

In line with Kaiser Permanente's mission to encourage health, many schools use these grants to promote student health through augmented on-campus counseling, health clerks or other wellness programs.

Some schools also use these grants to provide science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) or visual and performing arts programs.
